School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting

School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) grew out of the public's concern that children be safe in the school environment. The SESIR system was initiated to enable schools to track incidents and analyze patterns of violent, criminal or disruptive activity. The intent is for there to be complete and objective data from which to design interventions to improve the learning environment. SESIR standardizes the definitions of serious crimes and violent acts in schools.

Serious incidents related to school safety and discipline shall be accurately reported in a timely manner to the Office of Safe Schools through the School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) structure. Only incidents that are identified as SESIR incidents shall be reported as identified on a list maintained by the Florida Department of Education. The School Board of Lee County, Florida shall provide training to appropriate personnel in accordance with Florida law and State Board of Education rules as established by the Florida Department of Education.
